## Key 2018 Tax Law Changes

#### Standard Deduction

- Single-\$12,000
- Married Filing Joint—\$24,000
- Head of Household—\$18,000
- Qualifying Widower—\$11,900

#### Mileage Deduction

- Business Miles—54.5¢ per mile
- Charitable Service—14¢ per mile
- Medical Travel—18¢ per mile
- Child tax credit is doubled to \$2,000

#### Retirement Contributions

- SIMPLE IRA—\$12,500, catch-up is additional \$3,000
- Traditional IRA—\$5,500, catch-up is additional \$1,000
- Roth IRA—\$5,500, catch-up is additional \$1,000

#### Miscellaneous Itemized Deductions

No deduction is available on the Federal return for these items (union days, work-related travel, tax prep fees, work uniforms, etc.) Although unreimbursed job expenses are still deductible for PA and Local

#### HELOC Interest

No longer deductible unless loan proceeds are used for home improvements
